c) Rocky View School Board Trustee Report: Fiona Gilbert, Trustee (5 min)

Student Transportation

From January to April 2018, Rocky View Schools is asking for parent participation in a public student transportation consultation, aimed at addressing an anticipated \$1 million shortfall to the transportation budget. RVS is asking for feedback on several cost-saving measures (7 of which have been identified, however there may be more options) and/or proposals to transfer monies from instruction (classroom funding) to transportation. A 4-page informational communique and an online survey have been prepared for RVS parents to review and complete by **February 16.** There will also be 3 public meetings held, one in Airdrie, one in Chestemere and one in Cochrane on February 13 at Cochrane High at 7 pm.

The public will have the opportunity to present to the Board of Trustees at its March 1 public board meeting, and later in March a second online survey will be emailed, asking RVS parents to select the preferred transportation efficiency bundle. The Board will deliberate its decision on this matter on April 12. Since 2008 transportation costs have risen by 17.83%, while grant revenues rose by only 1.27% over the same time period. This shortfall in funding is further compounded by a \$360,000 levy for carbon, as well as a new Transportation Fee Replacement Grant that penalizes growing boards like RVS because it is based on 2015/16 fees and student counts. To guide its decision-making, the Board established 3 planning principles: ensure services continue to be safe for students; share the responsibility for balancing the transportation deficit among communities; and maintain current educational program offerings. A decision on transportation services has to be made so that it can be implemented by September 2018.

School Calendar (2018-2019): The deadline for the survey feedback of the two 2018-2019 Draft School calendars is Jan 26th. The feedback will be reviewed by the Board at the February 8, 2018 Board meeting, after which a decision on the school calendar will be made.
