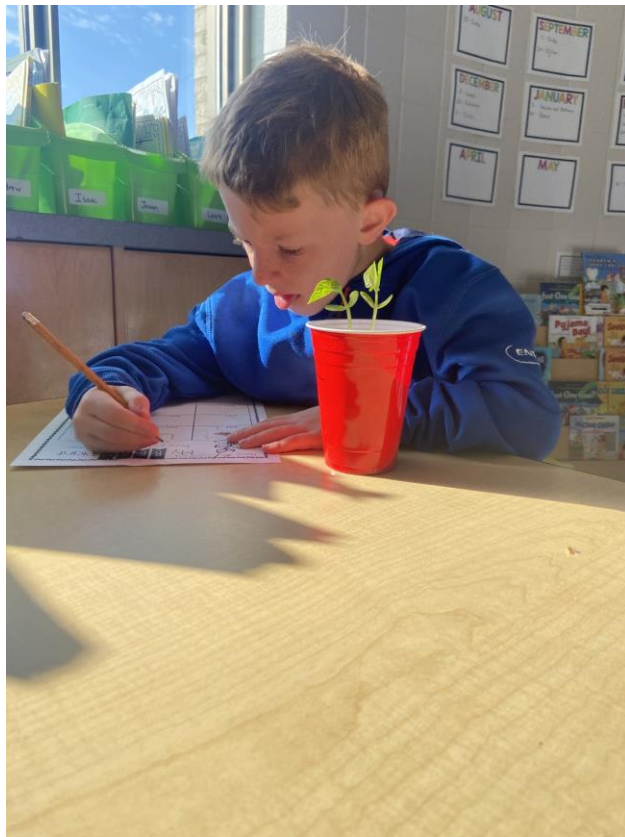

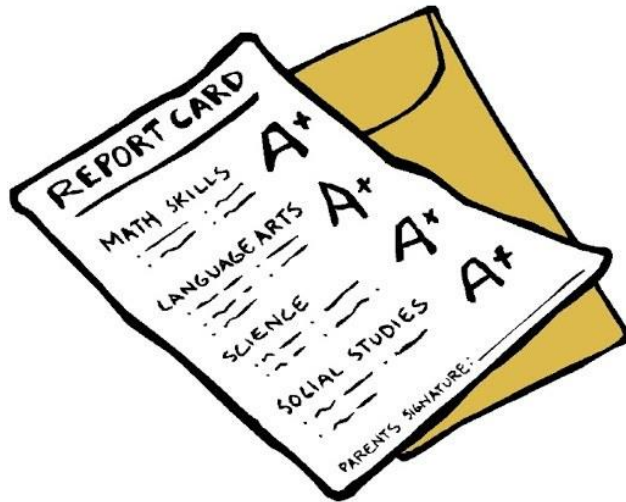








Important New Items

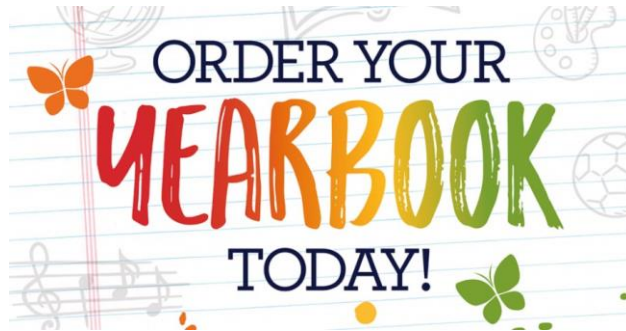

The last School Council Meeting of the school year and AGM will be held on Thursday, June 15th at 6:30 pm in the Learning Commons. May school council meeting minutes are posted on the CCA website. News from Rocky View Schools



Transportation registration is now open for the 2023/24 school year.

Register before July 21 to receive an early registration discount of \$40 (first two students in your family; \$20 off additional students). A minimum payment of 50 per cent is due at registration. Early registration will ensure your child is registered and assigned to a bus route for school start-up in September. To guarantee service for the first day of school, your application must be received before Aug. 15. Registration received after this deadline may experience delays of two to three weeks.
