- closed intersections around the school had us move buses to the side street, and move parent drop off to 1st Street E (will likely stay this way after construction is complete also)
- thank you to parents for parking and making this work through all the construction
- busing numbers have increased for our students from last year

### Bell Times:

- bell times have been softened by 20 minutes during construction
- if your child arrives before 8:22am they will not be marked late, while we deal with traffic and construction around the school
- if a student is arriving after 8:02am they must go through the front doors

### New School:

- middle school bathrooms were not fully updated during renovations, this may be something that is worked on down the road
  - bulletin boards are still to be added to hallways in the school
  - cement still to be poured
  - storage challenges that are trying to be worked out
  - we are still moving in; we are doing things and undoing things
  - at this time there is no full time school operator due to RVS restructuring
  - there is no full time custodian at this time, we are sharing a custodian with another school in Cochrane
  - working on setting up our new sound system
  - grade 2 and 3 are now entering through the same door
  - all doors are locked during the day except for the front door; once camera and buzzer are installed at the front door it will be locked at all times
  - teachers will be sending out emails every Friday to parents to keep communication open
  - agendas will be used daily
  - each night there will be practice for students to do: bible verses, words their way, math facts (the phonics of math), social, science
  - this work is not marked by teachers
  - 10 minutes per grade eg: max 50 minutes for grade 5
  - rolling our parent teacher conferences after thanksgiving
  - we will be moving away from Mathletics to IXL Math
  - homework will be posted in powerschool if something is missing for your child
  - Powerschool is a great way for parents to keep up
